Tetakawi - This majestic hill on the shores of the Sea of Cortez, is the symbol of San Carlos and much of the terrain where the desert meets the sea. From this hill, one appreciates the beautiful view of the beaches and the expanses of mountains and plains. The hill itself is about 200 meters (slightly more than 600 feet) high. Tetakawi has become a "must" for visitors from throughout Mexico and abroad.



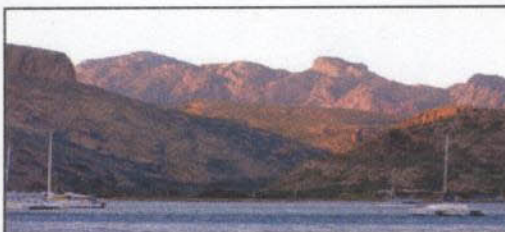
History of San Carlos

The Sea of Cortez (also called the Gulf of California) is a unique ocean environment formed millions of years ago when Baja California slid westward due to geological activity in the San Andreas Fault. The clear, mild waters of the sea are influenced by the warm tropical eastern Pacific, and attract many tropical marine species. It has over 800 species of fish, and over 400 species of shell, as well as several species of animals found in this unique area that occur nowhere else in the world. The Sea of Cortez is a dynamic body of water whose beaches are continually washed by the gentle waves. San Carlos is a small, but busy tourist town located just 4 hours by car from the border town of Nogales, AZ.
